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Preface

Every disciple will face an hour when emotion is not enough, memory is not enough, good intentions are not enough, and religious language is not enough. There will be moments when temptation speaks loudly, fear presses heavily, weakness feels near, decisions must be made quickly, and the soul must choose whether to stand on truth or surrender to feelings.

That is why the Word of God must not merely be near us. It must be in us.

Power for the Hour was created as a simple but powerful discipleship tool for believers who want the Word of God hidden in their hearts, ready on their lips, and active in their daily walk with Jesus. This booklet is not meant to be read once and placed on a shelf. It is meant to be used, memorized, spoken, prayed, meditated on, and lived.

The Scriptures gathered here have been arranged around the real needs of the Christian life: salvation, faith, prayer, healing, love, forgiveness, witnessing, obedience, strength, protection, supply, overcoming the devil, fearlessness, humility, unity, discipleship, and many other foundations every believer must know. These are not random verses. They are weapons, anchors, reminders, instructions, promises, and spiritual food.

A disciple who does not know the Word will always be vulnerable to confusion. But a disciple who carries the Word in his heart carries light in darkness, wisdom in uncertainty, strength in weakness, and truth in the face of lies. Jesus said, “Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.” That means the Word is not optional nourishment. It is daily life.

As you go through this booklet, do not rush. Read the verses slowly. Speak them aloud. Memorize them. Meditate on them. Let them correct your thinking, strengthen your faith, shape your decisions, and train your mouth to agree with God. Let the Word become your first response, not your last resort.

There will come an hour when you need strength. There will come an hour when you need courage. There will come an hour when you need wisdom, healing, faith, boldness, comfort, or direction. When that hour comes, the disciple must not be empty. The disciple must have power.

And that power is found in the living Word of God.

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Introduction

Welcome to Power for the Hour: Bible Verses to Memorize, Meditate On, and Live Out Daily.

Every disciple will face moments that demand more than good intentions. There will be hours of temptation, fear, weakness, decision, suffering, prayer, witnessing, and spiritual pressure. In those moments, the believer does not need empty religious language. He needs the living Word of God hidden in his heart, ready on his lips, and active in his daily walk with Jesus.

This booklet was created to help disciples memorize, meditate on, speak, and live out the Word of God. The verses gathered here are not random passages. They are foundations for faith, anchors for the soul, weapons against darkness, reminders of God's promises, and instructions for walking in obedience, courage, love, wisdom, and power.

As disciples of Jesus, we must allow the Word to become more than printed words on a page. The Word must become the bedrock of our convictions, the compass of our choices, and the strength we draw from in times of need. Scripture must shape the way we think, the way we speak, the way we pray, the way we respond, and the way we live.

Each verse in this booklet is a light in darkness and a reminder of the truth we stand upon. Through the discipline of memorization and meditation, we give the Word room to take root in our hearts. And as the Word takes root, it begins to renew the mind, strengthen faith, correct wrong thinking, and train the believer to walk in agreement with Christ.

Do not rush through these pages. Read the verses slowly. Speak them aloud. Memorize them. Meditate on them. Let them become part of your daily life. Whether you are facing trials or celebrating victories, let the Word guide you, strengthen you, and empower you to live out your faith boldly.

When the hour comes, the disciple must have power.

And that power is found in the living Word of God.

SALVATION

John 1:12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name.

John 3:3 Jesus answered and said to him, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.”

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

John 3:36 He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.

PRAYER

Psalms 66:18,19 If I regard iniquity in my heart, The Lord will not hear. But certainly God has heard me; He has attended to the voice of my prayer.

Jeremiah 29:13 And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.

Jeremiah 33:3 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'

Matthew 7:7,8 Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

Matthew 18:19 Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.

Mark 11:23,24 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.

Psalms 116:1,2 I love the Lord, because He has heard My voice and my supplications. Because He has inclined His ear to me, Therefore I will call upon Him as long as I live.

Isaiah 30:19b He will be very gracious to you at the sound of your cry; when He hears it, He will answer you.

Isaiah 65:24 It shall come to pass That before they call, I will answer; And while they are still speaking, I will hear.

Psalms 91:15a He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him;

Matthew 6:6b and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.

FAITH

Romans 4:20,21 He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.

Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

2 Corinthians 5:7 For we walk by faith, not by sight.

Hebrews 10:35 Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward.

Hebrews 10:38a Now the just shall live by faith;

Hebrews 11:1,6 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

1 John 5:4b And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith.

James 1:6 But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.

James 2:26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Matthew 9:29b According to your faith let it be to you.

Romans 14:23b for whatever is not from faith is sin.

HEALING

Exodus 15:26b I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the Lord who heals you.

Psalms 34:19 Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the Lord delivers him out of them all.

Psalms 103:3 Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases,

Psalms 107:20 He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Isaiah 53:5b bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripe we are healed.

Jeremiah 30:17a 'For I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds,' says the Lord.

Jeremiah 32:27 Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me?

Malachi 4:2a But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings;

Matthew 18:19 Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.

Luke 17:14b And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed.

James 5:14,15 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

Isaiah 40:29 He gives power to the weak, And to those who have no might He increases strength.

Acts 9:34 And Peter said to him, "Aeneas, Jesus the Christ heals you. Arise and make your bed." Then he arose immediately.

Matthew 4:23,24 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them.

Matthew 10:1 And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.

LOVE

Matthew 7:12 Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets.

Matthew 22:37-39 Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

John 13:35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

John 15:12 This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.

1 Corinthians 13:8a Love never fails.

1 Corinthians 16:14 Let all that you do be done with love.

1 Peter 4:8 And above all things have fervent love for one another, for “love will cover a multitude of sins.”

1 John 3:16 By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.

1 John 3:18 My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth.

1 John 4:8 He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

John 13:34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

John 15:17 These things I command you, that you love one another.

1 John 3:11 For this is the message that you heard from the beginning, that we should love one another,

1 John 3:23 And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment.

1 John 4:7a Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God;

FORGIVENESS

Matthew 6:14,15 For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Ephesians 4:32 And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to for-give us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

1 Peter 4:8b for “love will cover a multitude of sins.”

James 2:13 For judgment is without mercy to the one who has shown no mercy. Mercy triumphs over judgment.

OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH THE LORD

Psalms 111:10a The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom;

Proverbs 8:17 I love those who love me, And those who seek me diligently will find me.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”

Matthew 22:37,38 Jesus said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ This is the first and great commandment.”

John 14:23 Jesus answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.”

Romans 7:4 Therefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law through the body of Christ, that you may be married to another—to Him who was raised from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God.

2 Corinthians 6:16b “I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people.”

Ephesians 5:30 For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones.

James 4:8a Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.

Deuteronomy 6:5 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.

Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require of you, but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul,

Psalms 27:4 One thing I have desired of the Lord, That will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, To behold the beauty of the Lord, And to inquire in His temple.

Psalms 73:25 Whom have I in heaven but You? And there is none upon earth that I desire besides You.

Psalms 143:8a Cause me to hear Your lovingkindness in the morning, For in You do I trust; 2 **John 6** This is love, that we walk according to His commandments. This is the commandment, that as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it.

1 John 4:19 We love Him because He first loved us.

John 14:21 He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him.

Job 23:12 I have not departed from the commandment of His lips; I have treasured the words of His mouth More than my necessary food.

John 15:10 If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father’s commandments and abide in His love.

FELLOWSHIP

Hebrews 10:25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

Psalms 133:1 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brethren to dwell together in unity!

Ecclesiastes 4:9,10 Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor. For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, For he has no one to help him up.

Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.”

1 John 1:7a But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another.

WITNESSING

Psalms 126:6 He who continually goes forth weeping, bearing seed for sowing, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing bringing his sheaves with him.

Proverbs 11:30 The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who wins souls is wise.

Ezekiel 3:17-19 Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel; therefore hear a word from My mouth, and give them warning from Me: When I say to the wicked, ‘You shall surely die,’ and you give him no warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life, that same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at your hand. Yet, if you warn the wicked, and he does not turn from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you have delivered your soul.

Daniel 12:3 Those who are wise shall shine Like the brightness of the firmament, And those who turn many to righteousness Like the stars forever and ever.

Matthew 4:19 Then He said to them, “Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.”

Matthew 5:14-16 You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Matthew 9:37,38 Then He said to His disciples, “The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.”

Mark 8:38 For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels.

Mark 16:15 And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.”

John 15:16a You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain.

1 Corinthians 9:16 For if I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of, for necessity is laid upon me; yes, woe is me if I do not preach the gospel!

2 Timothy 2:23 But avoid foolish and ignorant disputes, knowing that they generate strife.

1 Peter 3:15b Always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;

GIVING

Proverbs 3:27,28 Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, when it is in the power of your hand to do so. Do not say to your neighbor, “Go, and come back, And tomorrow I will give it,” When you have it with you.

Proverbs 11:24,25 There is one who scatters, yet increases more; And there is one who withholds more than is right, But it leads to poverty. The generous soul will be made rich, And he who waters will also be watered himself.

Proverbs 19:17 He who has pity on the poor lends to the Lord, And He will pay back what he has given.

Malachi 3:10 “Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, That there may be food in My house, And try Me now in this,” Says the Lord of hosts, “If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing. That there will not be room enough to receive it.”

Luke 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.”

Acts 20:35b It is more blessed to give than to receive.

2 Corinthians 9:6,7 But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

1 John 3:17,18 But whoever has this world’s goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him? My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth.

HOW TO FIND THE WILL OF GOD

Psalms 32:8 I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will guide you with My eye.

Psalms 119:130 The entrance of Your words gives light; It gives understanding to the simple.

Psalms 143:8b Cause me to know the way in which I should walk, For I lift up my soul to You.

Proverbs 3:6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.

Proverbs 15:22 Without counsel, plans go awry, But in the multitude of counselors they are established.

Isaiah 30:21 Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the way, walk in it," Whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left.

Luke 22:42 saying, "Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done."

Romans 12:1,2 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

OBEDIENCE TO GOD

1 Samuel 15:22 So Samuel said: "Has the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed than the fat of rams.

Job 36:11 If they obey and serve Him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, And their years in pleasures.

Proverbs 11:2 When pride comes, then comes shame; But with the humble is wisdom.

Proverbs 16:18 Pride goes before destruction, And a haughty spirit before a fall.

Matthew 23:12 And whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.

Luke 6:41,42b And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the plank in your own eye? Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck that is in your brother's eye.

Proverbs 18:21a Death and life are in the power of the tongue,

Proverbs 29:11 A fool vents all his feelings, but a wise man holds them back.

Matthew 12:34b For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.

Matthew 12:36,37 But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."

Ephesians 4:29 Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.

But woe to him who is alone when he falls, for he has no one to help him up. Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

Amos 3:3 Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?

Romans 12:5 so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.

Romans 14:19 Therefore let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another.

Romans 16:17 Now I urge you, brethren, note those who cause divisions and offenses, contrary to the doctrine which you learned, and avoid them.

1 Corinthians 1:10 Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

2 Corinthians 6:17 Therefore “Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you.”

James 4:4 Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

1 John 2:15,16 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

PERSECUTION

Matthew 5:10-12 Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

Matthew 10:23a When they persecute you in this city, flee to another.

John 15:18 If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you.

John 15:20 Remember the word that I said to you, ‘A servant is not greater than his master.’ If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also.

John 16:2b yes, the time is coming that whoever kills you will think that he offers God service.

Philippians 1:29 For to you it has been granted on behalf of Christ, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake,

2 Timothy 3:12 Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.

BACKSLIDING

Psalms 37:31 The law of his God is in his heart; None of his steps shall slide.

2 Timothy 4:10a for Demas has forsaken me, having loved this present world, and has departed for Thessalonica.

Hebrews 10:38 Now the just shall live by faith; But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him.

Hebrews 11:15 And truly if they had called to mind that country from which they had come out, they would have had opportunity to return.

2 Peter 2:20-22 For if, after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and overcome, the latter end is worse for them than the beginning. For it would have been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than having known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered to them. But it has happened to them according to the true proverb: "A dog returns to his own vomit," and, "a sow, having washed, to her wallowing in the mire."

CHRISTIANITY IN CRISIS

Matthew 15:8,9 These people draw near to Me with their mouth, And honor Me with their lips, But their heart is far from Me. And in vain they worship Me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.

Matthew 22:29 Jesus answered and said to them, You are mistaken, not knowing the Scriptures nor the power of God.

Mark 7:9,13 He said to them, "All too well you reject the commandment of God, that you may keep your tradition. making the word of God of no effect through your tradition which you have handed down. And many such things you do."

Acts 7:48 However, the Most High does not dwell in temples made with hands, as the prophet says.

2 Timothy 3:5 having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

Revelations 3:15,16 I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth. (See Matthew 23 - Jesus rebuking the Scribes and Pharisees)

THE LAW OF CHRIST

Matthew 22:37-40 Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."

John 1:17 For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

Romans 3:28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith apart from the deeds of the law.

Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

Romans 10:4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

Romans 13:8b for he who loves another has fulfilled the law.

Galatians 2:21 I do not set aside the grace of God; for if righteousness comes through the law, then Christ died in vain.”

Galatians 3:13a Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us

Galatians 3:24,25 Therefore the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith. But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor.

Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.

Galatians 5:13 For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

Galatians 5:14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: “You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”

1 Timothy 1:9a knowing this: that the law is not made for a righteous person, but for the lawless and insubordinate,

James 2:10 For whoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all.

CREATION VS EVOLUTION

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Acts 14:15b and preach to you that you should turn from these useless things to the living God, who made the heaven, the earth, the sea, and all things that are in them,

Romans 1:20-22,25 For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened. Professing to be wise, they became fools, who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.

1 Timothy 6:20 Timothy! Guard what was committed to your trust, avoiding the profane and idle babblings and contradictions of what is falsely called knowledge—

2 Timothy 3:7 Always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.
