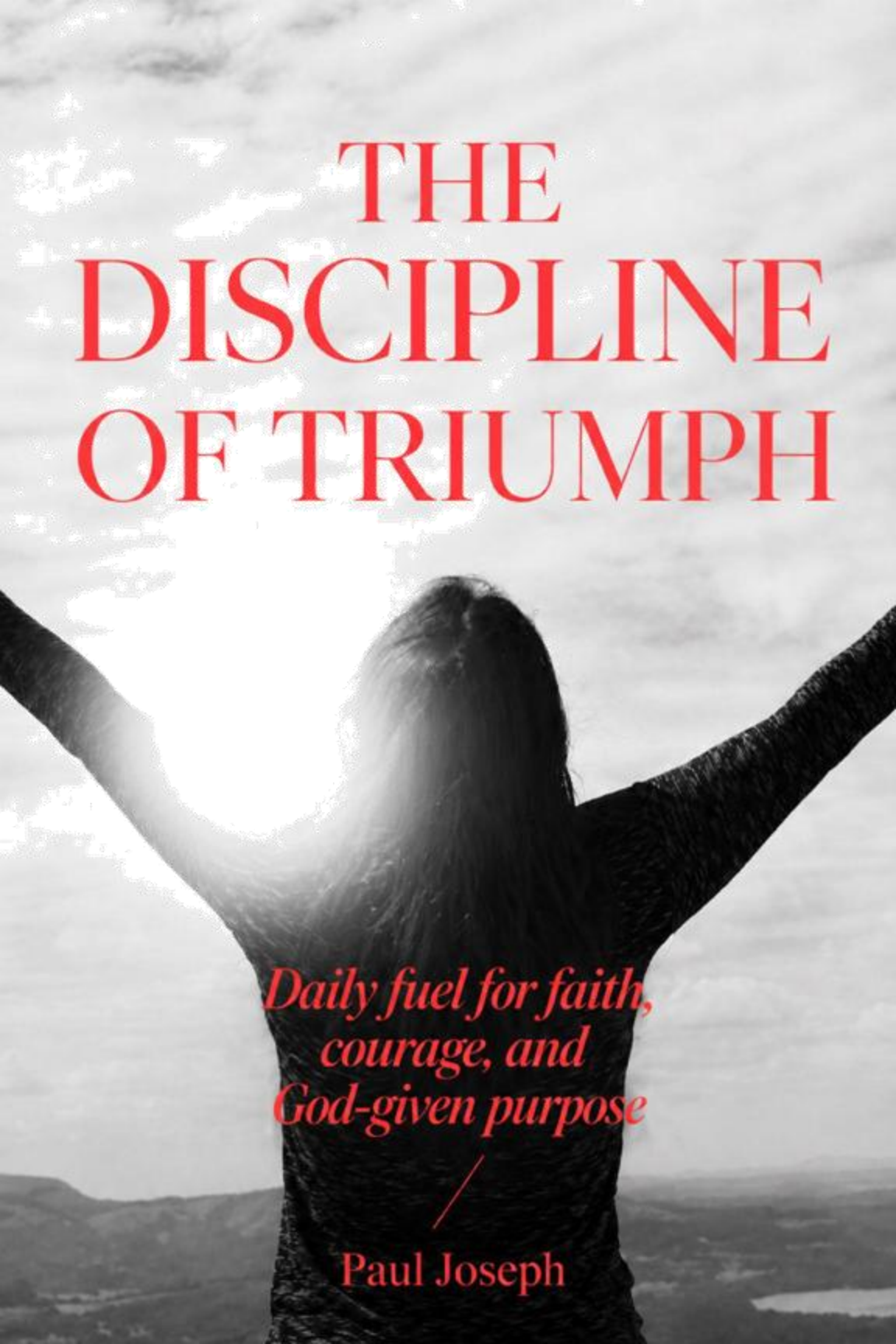

Preface

Triumph is not an accident. It is a discipline.

Every day brings its own battles, choices, responsibilities, opportunities, and tests of faith. Some days require courage. Some days require patience. Some days require wisdom. Some days require endurance when the results have not yet appeared. But every day also gives us an opportunity to grow stronger, think higher, believe deeper, and walk more faithfully with God.

This book was created as daily fuel for that journey.

Discipline of Triumph is not merely a collection of inspiring thoughts. It is a daily reminder that victory must be cultivated. Faith must be exercised. Courage must be practiced. Wisdom must be applied. Purpose must be pursued. God has placed gifts, abilities, and influence within each of us, but those things do not mature by accident. They must be developed through discipline, obedience, perseverance, and faith.

The Word says, “As a man thinketh in his heart, so is he” (Proverbs 23:7). That means the battle for a triumphant life begins in the heart and mind. If your thinking is shaped by fear, defeat, excuses, or limitation, your life will begin to follow that pattern. But when your mind is renewed by God’s Word, when your faith is stirred, when your attitude is aligned with heaven, and when your actions begin to agree with what God has spoken, your life begins to move in the direction of victory.

Triumph does not mean you will never face opposition. David still had to face Goliath. Paul still had to fight the good fight. Solomon still had to apply wisdom. Jesus Himself walked in obedience, discipline, service, authority, and sacrifice. Victory is not proven by the absence of pressure. Victory is proven when pressure cannot make you quit, bow, shrink back, or forget who God has called you to be.

That is why discipline matters.

Motivation may stir you for a moment, but discipline carries you through the process. Inspiration may light the fire, but discipline keeps it burning. Faith gives you vision, but discipline helps you walk it out. Courage helps you begin, but discipline helps you finish.

This book is designed to feed your faith daily. Each reflection, Scripture, and wisdom thought is meant to help renew your mind, strengthen your courage, sharpen your discipline, and remind you of your God-given purpose. Some days will encourage you. Some days will challenge you. Some days will correct your thinking. Some days will push you to rise again. But each day is meant to point you back to truth.

Do not read only for inspiration. Read for transformation. Let the Scripture speak first. Let the reflections search your attitude. Let the wisdom sharpen your decisions. Let each day become another step toward becoming the person God created you to be.

You were not created to drift through life. You were created to serve, build, lead, overcome, and influence the world around you. Whether your assignment is in your family, workplace, ministry, business, classroom, community, or personal walk with God, your life carries influence. The question is not whether you will influence others. The question is what kind of influence your life will release.

May Discipline of Triumph help you rise above small thinking, strengthen your faith, discipline your habits, and walk with courage in your God-given purpose.

You are not called to be overcome.

You are called to triumph every day.

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Introduction

We often refer to King Solomon as one of the clearest biblical examples of wisdom, leadership, and success because of the wisdom God granted him. The Word says, “And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore” (1 Kings 4:29). With that God-given wisdom, Solomon built God’s temple and ruled in righteousness.

The apostle Paul also fulfilled his destiny and calling by pressing forward with purpose. He said, “I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus” (Philippians 3:14). Near the end of his life, having pioneered and established the Christian faith throughout much of the surrounding region, he said, “I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith” (2 Timothy 4:7). Paul’s life reminds us that true success is not merely starting well. True success is finishing faithfully.

Born-again believers are called to carry influence because the life of Christ within us should affect the world around us. When our goal is to emulate Jesus, obey His Word, and apply His commandments to our lives, we begin to live with Kingdom purpose. God has given each of us abilities, gifts, aptitudes, and leadership traits. As believers, our main objective in this life is to use these qualities to bring the Kingdom of God on earth as it is in heaven. “Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven” (Matthew 6:10).

Jesus gave us authority while He was here on earth so we could continue the works He commanded us to do. He said, “As you go, proclaim this message: ‘The kingdom of heaven has come near.’ Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you have received; freely give” (Matthew 10:5–8). He then promised us the Holy Spirit to be our Guide and Helper: “But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to

your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you” (John 14:26). When we follow God’s plan, we naturally become “managers” in whatever sphere of influence and geographical area He has placed us. As such, we must take on the mindset of Jesus’ authority and dominion.

That is one of the purposes of Jesus’ redemption of man: to restore man to his God-given dominion under Christ’s authority here on earth. Here are a couple of analogies. God uses the image of the eagle to describe His care and strength toward His children (Deuteronomy 32:11; Exodus 19:4). Jesus, of course, is the Lion of Judah (Revelation 5:5). Both the eagle and the lion carry images of strength, confidence, and leadership. The lion is not the tallest, biggest, smartest, or heaviest animal in the jungle, yet he carries himself as king. His strength is not only in his body, but in his perception. The lion sees the elephant as his meal. Even though the elephant is bigger, it is not a problem. He is conditioned by what he thinks. It’s our mind that makes us the leader. Attitudes generate behavior. Attitude is a product of belief. The lion is the king because of what he thinks about himself.

You can change the perception of who you are. You must discover that your life matters and that you were born to contribute something important to the world. This is especially true when you are born again. In Christ, you have received more than forgiveness. You have received identity, purpose, authority, grace, and the Spirit of God. With that comes responsibility. We must take responsibility for influencing the world around us.

God gives us the picture of the eagle as an image of renewed strength: “But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint” (Isaiah 40:31). The eagle rises above the storm. It does not live on the ground like ordinary birds. It was created to soar. In the same way, faith lifts us above the limitations, fears, and pressures that try to keep us low. That is one of the costs of leadership: you cannot let fear, small thinking, or the opinions of others keep you grounded. You have to let your faith lead you and lift you.

Remember the story of the twelve spies who went into the Promised Land. Ten of them saw the giants and said, “We were in our own sight as grasshoppers” (Numbers 13:33). If you think you’re a grasshopper, you’ll be one, and you’ll die one. In fact, that’s exactly what happened to them.

But David saw differently when he faced Goliath. He did not define the battle by the size of the giant. He defined it by the covenant and power of God. He said, “Who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?” (1 Samuel 17:26). Potential is not enough without faith to activate it. Ability can remain buried under the wrong mentality. Confidence is the product of belief. It all comes down to our faith in what God has provided by grace, so we can lead and influence others.

The Word of God is filled with truth and wisdom. And when we know and understand God’s Word, we’re able to share powerful truths wherever we are. King David said, “Your commands make me wiser than my enemies, because they are mine forever. I am wiser than all my teachers, because I think about your rules. I have more understanding than the elders, because I follow your orders” (Psalm 119: 97-103).

This is also why parents carry such influence. Parents can instill a strong belief system in their children by encouraging them to create and to believe they can become everything they aspire to be. They too can learn that their life is shaped by the way they think. “As a man thinketh in his heart, so is he” (Proverbs 23:7). Children often value what their parents value. If you value creativity, discipline, faith, excellence, service, and accomplishment, your children are more likely to value the same. In that sense, every parent is a leader and a motivator.

Leadership is inherent in the spirit, but it must be discovered and developed. Do not let anything negative from your past hold you back. Don’t limit yourself to your heritage or your ethnicity. Your identity in God is greater than every label the world tries to place on you. Become like your Father. What you believe to be true will shape what you do with your life. Truth determines direction. Direction deter-

mines altitude. And altitude determines what you are able to see, reach, and influence.

We must focus on the gifts and talents God has placed within us. We must develop them, cultivate them, discipline them, and share them. Success is not merely about personal achievement. True success is using what God has given you to serve others, influence the world around you, and bring glory to Him. That is the purpose of this book.

Each day is an opportunity to think higher, believe stronger, act wiser, serve better, and triumph through Christ. These daily reflections are meant to renew your mind, stir your faith, sharpen your discipline, and remind you that you were not created to drift through life.
